#### **BASIC RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES**

- Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item pick-up day is Wednesday (unless follows a holiday—see calendar above).
- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item must be curb side by 6:00 AM on your scheduled collection day.
- No more than four (4) trash bags/cans will be collected each week.
- ♦ Bags or containers must not exceed 32 gallons or 50 pounds each.
- Call Penn Waste to schedule collection of appliances containing Freon (air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.)
- No construction debris will be collected curb side.
- ♦ 2018 Quarterly Flat Billing is \$58.20, Per Bag—26 bags minimum annually (\$5.50 x 26) = \$143.00, Each additional bag is \$5.50.
